

Dear Parents & Whānau,

As part of our **2025 Education Outside of the Classroom (EOTC) week,** from December 8th to 12th December, we are planning on holding Three major camps and numerous other activities in and around Wellington. All SWIS Students are involved and will take part in EOTC week.

The purpose of this notice is to provide some information so that students can indicate which of the EOTC options they would like to take part in. Students have been presented with the options at our School Assembly on Friday, 22nd August.

The notice starts with information about the Overnight Experiences/camps. An estimated contribution towards the cost for each activity is included in the descriptions. We will need parent help for each of the trips. Please do not volunteer yet we will ask for this after we have put students into groups.

Below these are details of all the other EOTC options that are based in and around Wellington, again the estimated cost of the contribution towards activities is included in the description. These activities offer plenty of challenges and interest. All EOTC activities are run in the same week and the whole school is involved.

We are working with New World Newtown to raise funds to reduce the cost of these activities and to support families who need it. If you are able to make a donation to support students other than your own this is gratefully accepted (these donations are also tax deductible).

Students will be sent a google form on Monday, 25th August to make their preferences known. Students are asked to indicate if they wish to do one, both or all three of the camps/overnight group trips and then to choose their 4 top choices for local activities. Students will have a week to complete this form. This will be sent to their school email addresses.

Overnight Experiences/Camps

Resolution Bay

Situated in Queen Charlotte Sound, Resolution Bay provides opportunities for walking, swimming, kayaking, and fishing. Travelling by ferry and water taxi campers will arrive on Monday and our adventure will begin. Accommodation and food will be provided for by Resolution Bay Cabins. Bring your walking shoes and togs for a great week!

Abel Tasman

Discover the beauty of Abel Tasman in this action packed week! Leaving on Monday, we travel by ferry and Bus to Kaiteriteri. From our base at Camp Bethany we will explore the local surroundings by Kayaking, Paddle Boarding, Waka Ama, Walking, and Swimming. You will need to bring your boundless energy and sense of fun as we explore this special part of New Zealand. We will return on Friday evening.
